These ADDITIONAL RULES & REGULATIONS FOR TEAMS are essential components of

- RULES & REGULATIONS

TEAM REQUIREMENTS

- Competition entry subject to registration and paid membership fees
- Teams are selected and invited by the WBQA office or presidents of member countries
- Participation subject to paid competition fees by given deadline
- Minimum members per team is two (2), ideally no more than six (6), with a maximum of ten (10). People who support or entertain the public are not included.
- Age minimum of all team members 16 years +
- One appointed captain (minimum 18 years +)
- Team captain must attend MANDATORY team captains' meeting prior to start of competition. Rules & Regulations are explained with an opportunity for questions and answers.
- Name of team is at free choice but may not be too long (to fit onto certificates etc.).
 Organizer reserved the right to abbreviate if need be. Sponsors must not be components of the name unless the company is owned by the Team Captain (e. g. Bosch BBQ Bulls).

TEAMS

TEAMS AREA

Each team is assigned a defined area in the competition.

Size allocation with a minimum of 20 m2 as determined by the organizer. All equipment including cooker, canopy, and trailer must be contained within this defined space.

Teams are responsible for their own security and insurance – consider taking out appropriate policy.

Teams are expected to provide all equipment and supplies needed for the management, preparation, and cooking within the event, except where arranged by the organizer.

BARBECUES

Fires must be of charcoal, briquettes, wood pellets, lump wood, or gas – "as long as there is fire underneath".

ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT



TURN-IN FOR JUDGING

- Team Captain or designated team member will bring turn-in at designated time to the receiving station at the judges' area.
- NO food presentation that indicate origin of team.
- Main Component not to be hidden, i. e. Main Component & Side Dish must be visible and distinguishable.
- Turn-in according to official times, publicly announced.
- Turn-in five (5) minutes before until five (5) minutes after the stipulated turn-in time, e. g. turn-in time is 12pm: time tolerance is 11.55am 12.05pm.
- Turn-in marked with registration number
- Registration number will be changed to anonymous coding for judging at receiving station.
- Change of wrong registration number allowed within the turn-in time.
- It is also the team's responsibility to inform the Organizer / Head Judge where breaches in rules are committed.
